

Rising Star Basic Camp

Feedback Summary Report

Based on 12 feedback form submissions received between July 2, 2026 and July 15, 2026.

Submissions are labeled bc1–bc16 in the order received. bc7 and bc11 were not part of this set, and two duplicates (bc10, identical to bc8; and bc15, identical to bc1) have been excluded, leaving 12 unique responses.

bc2: *Court presence and positioning.*

bc3: *Honestly cannot remember because it's been so long since the camp, but I know there was useful feedback.*

bc4: *The interaction with some was very helpful. I would like to see how each clinicians grade me. I feel some games I did not do as well and grade poorly do to trying to help a less seasoned official which I feel in turn made me look less than. Not saying I'm gods, I have a long way to go, but trying to make the team look good instead of concentrating on me.*

bc5: *Yes, I try to stay active but learned ways to be more efficient and strategic with my floor movement. I mainly do two man games so this will be good taking into the next season.*
